HAIR COLOUR BRANDS

ALL OUR HAIR COLOURS FALL INTO 4 GROUPS

PERMANENT

As the name suggests, these colours give a permanent result and a retouch will be required once the hair has new growth. Permanent colours are versatile, in that they can lighten natural hair, darken, add colour and cover greys completely.













LONG LASTING SEMI PERMANENT

Often called a 'demi colour' by hairdressers, these colours provide amazing shine, are low commitment and perfect for covering first greys. They gradually fade with each shampoo, lasting around 28 washes.

SEMI PERMANENT

These colours add shine and colour tones, they are low commitment and fade with each shampoo, lasting anywhere from 5 - 20 washes depending on the shade chosen and the porosity of the hair.





TEMPORARY

Temporary colours last 1 wash. They are perfect for touching up your colour and concealing greys in between colouring.

THE HAIR STRUCTURE

When we know how the hair is structured and its different layers, we can better understand and explain to our customers how the different hair colour types work on the hair.

FUN HAIR FACTS

- Average number of hairs on scalp: 100,000
- Average hair loss per day: 60
- Growth rate: 1cm (1/2 inch) per month

PERMANENT COLOUR

Penetrates through to the cortex middle layer, lightens the melanin and simultaneously deposits the new hair colour pigments.

LONG LASTING SEMI-PERMANENT COLOUR


The colour pigments penetrate just inside the cortex middle layer and there is minimal/no lightening of the natural melanin.

SEMI -PERMANENT COLOUR

Deposits the hair colour pigments just underneath the cuticle outside layer scales.

TEMPORARY COLOUR

These colourants sit on the outside of the hair on top of the cuticle layer. This why they last only 1 shampoo.



THE HAIR SHAFT

CUTICLE OUTER LAYER

The protective outer layer is made up of tiny clear scales that should lay flat and overlap. This creates a flat surface so light will bounce off which gives our hair its shiny appearance.

The cuticle layer can become damaged and therefore affect our hairs condition by misuse of chemicals, lifestyle factors and heated styling tools.

CORTEX -MIDDLE LAYER

The most fibrous part of the hair contains both keratin fibres which give our hair its strength, and melanin which is our natural hair colour pigment.

MEDULLA - INNER CORE

Has no known function and can sometimes be totally absent from very fine hair. Its made up of dead cell deposits separated by air bubbles and has no impact at all when colouring hair.

WHAT THE NUMBERS ON THE FRONT OF THE PACKS MEAN

On the following pages we explain how you can use these numbers to accurately determine each shade using our global numbering system.

The L'Oréal Group International Numbering System is used in over 150 countries worldwide and covers many language barriers.

It is a very simple system, which makes selecting a hair colour easy.

The numbering system is applicable to almost all L'Oréal Group permanent and long lasting semi permanent hair colour ranges.

*The system combines 2 individual numbering scales to create many different shades.

- **1. BASE SHADES** determine how dark or light natural hair or a colourant is.
- 2. **REFLECTS** these are the pure colour tones we add to colourants to create on trend shades and tones to suit customer hair colour needs. The reflect tones are based on the universal colour wheel as shown on the next page, and are made up of both primary and secondary colours. These pure pigments we add are the key to creating a diverse range of shades.

1. THE BASE SHADES


The scale from 1 through 10 is used to measure the depth of colour from Black to Very Light Blonde. This system is used to measure both natural hair colour and artificial colourants.

The difference between two successive shades is called a level.

i.e. the difference between a 5 and a 6 is one level.

L'ORÉAL GROUP COLOUR WHEEL*




SEEN IN VISIBLE LIGHT WHICH ARE KNOWN AS PRIMARY COLOURS.




When equal quantities of the 3 primary colours – blue, red and yellow are mixed together a brown shade is the result. Brown is often referred to as a neutral shade.

The mixing of two primary colours creates a secondary colour, of which there are three.



Each secondary colour neutralises its complementary or opposite colour and it is important to understand these colour principles so as to know which colours can be applied over existing reflects in the hair.



^{*}The numbers and descriptions given to each of the primary and secondary colours on the wheel are exclusive to the L'Oréal Group.

2. THE REFLECTS

THE SCALE FROM 1 THROUGH 6 REPRESENTS THE TONES OR REFLECTS ADDED TO THE BASE SHADE TO CREATE FASHIONABLE SHADES:



REFLECT EXAMPLES 8 4 8.4 Blonde + Copper = Copper Plands

- The first number always represents the base shade
- The second number represents the reflect added
- Some shades have double reflects added giving more colour intensity e.g. 8.34 Golden Copper Blonde

When two reflects are present, the first one is the more dominant of both.

For example, 8.34 the gold 3 is more dominant than the copper 4.

- A 0 before the reflect softens the tone that follows. For example, 8.04 has a little Copper 4 (orange pigment) added creating a soft natural copper blonde result.
- A 0 after the reflect intensifies the reflect added. For example, 8.40 has extra Copper 4 (orange pigment) added to create an intense copper blonde.

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PERMANENT COLOUR



HOW IT WORKS

CHARACTERISTICS

- Permanent colours simultaneously lighten and deposit colour into the hair. They can colour in a lighter shade, the same shade, a darker shade or add reflects such as gold, copper, red or ash tones.
- Permanent colours grow out, they do not wash out with shampooing.
- Re-application is required at the root of the hair for new hair growth (approximately every 4-6 weeks).
- Permanent hair colours can cover up to 100% white/grey hair.

NB: As there are some variances of white hair coverage within the individual brands and their shades, it is important to select the correct shade and range to achieve the desired result. Permanent Colours can lighten natural hair only, they will not lighten a previously applied permanent hair colour that is darker than the newly selected one.

REQUIRES THE MIXING OF 2 PRODUCTS

- 1. A gel or crème formulation containing colourants and typically ammonia or similar ingredient.
- 2. Mixed with developer containing hydrogen peroxide.

PREPARING THE HAIR FOR COLOURATION

The ammonia when combined with the hydrogen peroxide in the developer opens the cuticle and frees the oxygen in the developer to begin the coloration process.

LIGHTENING HAIR

The colouration process first lightens the hair's natural melanin pigments before new colour pigments are absorbed. This also occurs when using darker shades.

DARKENING HAIR

The hair is simultaneously lightened and coloured with the new colour pigments. The colour result is a combination of superimposing the new darker pigments onto the lightened hair.

AFTER COLOUR CONDITIONERS AND SHAMPOOS - IMPORTANT INFO

The role of the after-colouring conditioner or shampoo in the pack is to eliminate any excess colourants and carry out a neutralising action to re-establish the hairs pH balance. By closing the cuticle this 'locks' the new colourant pigments within the hair.

PERMANENT COLOUR INFO & TIPS

The end result of a permanent colour will depend on:

- The hair's natural colour
- The presence of any previously applied colour
- The shade selected
- The brand characteristics. e.g. grey coverage or extra lightening
- . The time the product is allowed to develop
- . The condition/quality or porosity of the hair

1. WHAT IS MY NATURAL HAIR COLOUR?

Establish the natural base shade before selecting a range or shade. Our natural base shades range from 1 Black to 10 Very Light Blonde. See page 7.

2. HOW LIGHT CAN I GO WITH A PERMANENT COLOUR?

Permanent colour can lighten the natural hair colour by 1 to 2 shades. For desired shades which are more than 2 levels lighter than the natural hair colour, a bleaching product must first be used prior to the application of the permanent colour. This process is called pre-lightening. For this two-step application we recommend first seeking advice from a professional hairdresser or team of experts on 1300 659 359.

NB: Some permanent colour ranges have specific shades formulated with extra lightening ability, these shades can lighten natural hair colour from 1 to 3 or 1 to 4 shades depending on the brand and specific characteristics.

3. RE-APPLYING COLOUR

Permanent colour repeatedly applied over existing colour may give a result which is too dark, this is known as colour build-up. Therefore, if using a similar shade continuously, it is recommended to do a 'retouch' application (Method 2 as explained in the Instruction Leaflet) whereby the colour mixture is first applied to the new growth, then the remaining colour mixture is massaged through the lengths and ends for a shorter development time to refresh the existing colour. This ensures an even colour result from root to tip.

NB: Always check instruction leaflet for specific product timing

4. STRAND TESTS

A strand test can be done prior to colouring the hair all over to see a preview of the final result. Mix 1/4 of the colourant with 1/4 of the developer ensuring you re-seal both bottles/tubes, and apply to a strand of hair approximately 1cm wide from roots to tips. Leave colour mixture to develop for the recommended development time. Check the colour, then proceed by mixing the remaining product and applying to the rest of the hair.

5. VERY THICK AND LONG HAIR

If the hair is longer than shoulder length, or is very thick, it is suggested to use 2 boxes of colour to achieve a true and even colour result.

There are some instances where its best to recommend our customers seek additional advice from our Consumer Affairs expert team on 1300 659 359 or a professional hair stylist.

Listed below are two instances when this would apply. (6 & 7)

6. USING A NEW LIGHTER SHADE — COLOUR WON'T LIGHTEN COLOUR

Permanent colour cannot lighten an existing shade already applied to the hair, which is darker than the new desired shade. To achieve a new lighter shade, a bleaching product must first be used to remove the excess darker colourants before applying the new, lighter shade.

NB: Some brands are not recommended to use over bleached or pre-lightened hair, so always check pack and instruction leaflet prior to selection.

7. HOW DARK CAN I GO USING A PERMANENT HAIR COLOUR?

As dark as you wish, however if your desired shade is 2 or more shades deeper, you may need to add some additional colour pigment to the hair prior to prevent it looking 'flat' or greenish. This process is known as 'filling' the hair.







BLEACHING AND LIGHTENING LEVELS






















Natural lightening occurs when the hair is exposed to water, light and air. The water swells the hair, oxygen molecules then penetrate the hair fibre and are activated by heat from the sun, resulting in warm sunlights.

It is possible to achieve a greater degree of lightening to the hair with a chemical action using a bleaching product. These have the ability to activate a greater degree of lightening thus resulting in the elimination of more pigments, and a lighter effect.

Lightening/bleaching products, depending on the relevant instructions can be used for:

- 1. Blonding. Lighten the hair to a particular shade of blonde.
- 2. Cleansing. Remove previously applied colour which is darker than the newly selected shade to be applied.
- 3. **Pre-Lightening.** Pre-lighten hair before adding a new shade which is 3 or more levels lighter than the natural hair colour or a fashion shade for a brighter effect.

Once a bleaching product is applied, the hair's natural melanin or artificial pigments are removed and the hair gradually lightens passing through the various stages of red to orange to yellow. It is not advisable to remove all traces of yellow pigments as this can result in damaging the integral structure of the hair. The difference between two shades is referred to as a 'Level'.

Lightening products can lighten the hair for 1 to 6 levels depending on the product selected, and/or the amount of previously applied colour present on the hair.

i.e. Previously applied dark shades such as blue-black can take longer to remove as they have very high concentrations of pigments.

Once the hair is lightened it is a permanent effect. It is not recommended to lighten black or very dark hair to a light blonde shade. Consult a professional hairdresser for more advice.

HOW IT WORKS

PRODUCT APPLICATION

The lightening action is caused by using a crème or gel (containing ammonia) or a powder (containing persulfate salts) mixed with a developer (hydrogen peroxide).


LIGHTENING

Once the mixture is applied to the hair it immediately swells the cortex (hair fibre containing the pigment), allowing the mix to penetrate the hair.

Then, the hydrogen peroxide combined with the ammonia-carrying ingredients or persulfate salts work together to gradually dissolve the pigments to be removed.

AFTER LIGHTENING CONDITIONER

The after-care conditioner/shampoo carries out a neutralising action and helps to close the hair's cuticle layer.



CUSTOMER TIPSFOR COLOURING AT HOME

1. CHOOSING THE COLOUR

The end result is determined by your natural hair colour and a good guide is to select a shade within two shades lighter or two shades darker than your natural shade. If you already have colour in your hair, this too can determine the end result.

2. PREPARATION

Keep a couple of old towels on hand to use each time you colour as it can stain or bleach towels. Wear an old or pre-loved T-shirt or button-up shirt just in case, and ensure you have all the components necessary such as gloves, instruction leaflet, comb, clips etc. on hand before you start applying.

3. WHERE TO START THE APPLICATION

This depends on the product so be guided by the Instruction Leaflet as some require roots first and others midlengths and ends first. When covering grey it is best to start at the whitest area first.

4. ENSURING THE BEST AND MOST EVEN COVERAGE

To ensure an even application, part the hair into four sections (like a hot cross bun!) from front to back down the centre, and from ear to ear. Then apply the colour to each quarter section by section and this will ensure even coverage.

5. HOW MUCH TIME TO ALLOW FROM START TO FINISH?

This will depend on the product used. but a general guide would be 1 to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours from start to finish.

6. HOW LONG SHOULD THE COLOUR STAY ON?

The development time is specified on the pack and must be adhered to, to ensure the best possible result. Extensive testing has already been done with the formulation to ensure its effectiveness.

7. CAN HAIR COLOUR BE USED TO COLOUR OTHER HAIR ON THE BODY?

No, L'Oréal Paris colourants are formulated to colour the hair on the scalp and must not be used to colour eyebrows, eyelashes or anywhere else.

8. SPECIAL CARE

Coloured hair requires the care of specifically formulated shampoos, conditioners and treatments as these products contain ingredients such as UV filters and moisturising agents to help prevent fade, and maintain the shine and colour. L'Oréal Paris and Garnier have has developed products specifically for the care of coloured hair.

9. THE COLOUR OF THE MIXTURE WHILST IT IS DEVELOPING

The actual colour of the mix whilst it is developing is not always an indication of the final result, so if in doubt, use a paper towel to wipe a strand of hair to get a better idea.

10. AFTER THE PRODUCT HAS BEEN MIXED CAN IT BE KEPT FOR ANOTHER APPLICATION?

No, once it has been mixed it must be used immediately as it loses its efficiency once mixed. This is why the components are packaged separately.
